<b>AMC</b>	<p><b>Training and Assessment:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Certification of completion of PGY2. *TBC</li> </ul> <p><b>Quality Assurance:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Accreditation following current cycle with monitoring reports to describe progress towards implementation.</li> </ul> <p><b>e-portfolio (TBC):</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Support introduction of new framework for PGY1 and PGY2.</li> </ul>	<p><b>*Note:</b> Not confirmed if changes for PGY2 will be implemented in 2024 or 2025</p>
<b>PMCs</b>	<p><b>Training Environment:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Implement new national standards and program /term requirements for PGY1 and PGY2.</li> <li>• Accreditation likely to follow current cycle but will require mechanisms for ensuring health services have made changes to deliver revised requirements from 2024.</li> <li>• Major changes include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Mandated use of national standards</li> <li>○ Expansion to PGY2</li> <li>○ Strengthened Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander standards</li> <li>○ Strengthened prevocational doctor wellbeing standards</li> <li>○ Changes in the way programs/ terms are classified</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Some components will have extended timeframes and/or flexibility: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Supervisor training expectations. [3 years post-implementation, expect some training to begin in 2023]</li> <li>○ PGY2 requirements</li> <li>○ Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander requirements</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><b>Quality Assurance:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Implementation of accreditation changes for PGY1 and PGY2.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Note:</b> National standards to be implemented in 2024 regardless of PGY2 implementation date. However, there will be flexibility in meeting some of these standards in the first year e.g.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander standards</li> <li>• PGY2 requirements</li> <li>• Program level breadth requirements (PGY2 in particular)</li> <li>• Training and assessment requirements – TBC in relation to implementation date for PGY2</li> </ul>
<b>Health services (and Jurisdictions)</b>	<p><b>Training and Assessment:</b></p> <p>Implement training and assessment changes for PGY1 and PGY2, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• EPA assessments [relatively fixed deadline]</li> <li>• Certification of completion of PGY2.</li> <li>• Have an established assessment review panel [fixed deadline]</li> </ul> <p><b>Training Environment:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have completed review and gap analysis of all existing programs and terms to revised requirements for PGY1 and PGY2 [fixed deadline]</li> <li>• Review and update all existing term descriptions to meet revised requirements [fixed deadline]</li> <li>• Implement new national standards and program/term requirements for PGY1 and PGY2. Some components will have extended timeframes:</li> <li>• Complete supervisor training [3 years post-implementation, expect some training to begin in 2023]</li> </ul>
