

WBA PROVIDER ACCREDITATION PROCESS



Notice of intent

At least 12 months in advance of the planned implementation

The provider submits the AMC with a notice of intent to deliver a WBA program.



Application for initial accreditation

At least 6 months in advance of the planned implementation

The provider submits a detailed submission for initial accreditation for consideration by the AMC Prevocational Standards Accreditation Committee.



Initial accreditation granted

Based on the recommendation of the Prevocational Standards Accreditation Committee, the AMC will consider approval for initial accreditation.



Implementation of WBA program

Following approval for initial accreditation, the WBA program may commence delivery.



First cohort completes program

At completion of the program, candidate assessment results are considered by the AMC for endorsement of AMC Certificate for general registration.



AMC Accreditation

After considering the results of the first cohort, the AMC will consider the program for full accreditation. Accreditation may be granted for up to four years.



Annual monitoring

The AMC will seek annual monitoring reports of how the program continues to meet the accreditation standards for AMC-accredited WBA provider.
