

AMC CERTIFICATE

From 1 December 2021, the AMC commenced with an electronic AMC certificate process.

The purpose of the AMC examinations is for non-specialist IMGs (not Australian graduates) to be **assessed** as part of the standard pathway to **registration**

Please note: The AMC certificate will be issued with the first and last names as stated on the candidate's AMC account. No name changes to the AMC certificate will be accepted once the certificate has been issued.

IMGs *required* to submit their medical degree (final medical diploma/primary qualification) in medicine and surgery for verification. It is important to determine that your medical school as well as your degree title and graduation year is **eligible**.
