What is expected in 2024?



Components relating to Training and Assessment requirements

- All prevocational doctors to have beginning of term discussions
- Mid and end of term assessments using the revised term assessment form
- Assessment review panels established and trained
- Commenced assessor training (revised term assessment forms)



Components relating to **National standards and requirements**

- Implement revised national standards
- All supervisors provided with a brief of the revised Framework and requirements (open access information provided by AMC)
- All terms assigned to 1 or 2 clinical experience categories
- Combinations of terms reviewed to ensure they meet revised requirements
- Term descriptions completed for all existing PGY1 and PGY2 terms
- All current documents reviewed and updated to meet revised national standards and requirements
- Survey teams trained in assessing using revised national standards
- PMC accreditation of health services to begin using revised national standards
- PMCs to communicate implementation plans with health services.
- Health services reporting to PMCs on progress and preparation

Components relating to AMC Domains and Procedures

- AMC accreditation of PMCs to begin using revised Domains
- PMCs reporting to AMC on progress and preparation

What other activities might training providers consider undertaking?

- Some rollout of EPA assessments in 2024 (paperbased, not formally part of assessment)
- Commenced assessor training (EPAs and EPA assessment forms)
- Supervisor training to support implementation of EPA assessment (in addition to being provided with a brief of the revised Framework and requirements)
