## AMC CERTIFICATE

The purpose of the AMC examinations and assessment process is for non-specialist International Medical Graduates (IMGs) (not Australian or New Zealand graduates) to be <u>assessed</u> as part of the standard pathway to <u>registration</u> with the Medical Board of Australia.	
Please note: The AMC certificate will be issued with the first and last names as stated on the candidate's AMC candidate ac- count.	
No name changes to the AMC certificate will be accepted once the certificate has been issued.	
IMGs are <i>required</i> to submit their medical degree (final medical diploma/primary qualification) in clinical medicine and surgery for verification. It is important to determine that your medical school as well as your degree title and graduation year is <u>eligible</u> .
