

# Online Examination dates for October and November 2025 Priority Scheduling

The AMC will continue implementing priority scheduling for the online clinical exams. This initiative reflects the AMC's commitment to supporting International Medical Graduates (IMGs) working in rural and remote areas of Australia.

Priority will be given to IMGs currently employed in the medical workforce in rural and remote locations. This change ensures that IMGs supporting healthcare delivery in underserved areas can access online exam opportunities in a timely manner.


The AMC recognises the vital contribution of IMGs in addressing healthcare needs across Australia, particularly in rural, remote, and very remote areas. This prioritisation aims to:

- Facilitate progression toward full registration for IMGs working in these regions.
- Support the delivery of healthcare services where they are needed most.
- Acknowledge the challenges faced by IMGs in accessing exams while working in rural and remote areas.

# How it works

The ranking criteria will be based on the Modified Monash Model (MMM). This model is a government framework for classifying remoteness and access to services in Australia.

For more information on this model please click here <u>Modified Monash Model</u>. Applications will be ranked by MMM category and time of email application with supporting documents.



Applications are invited from candidates living and working as medical practitioners in areas classified as MMM 3-7 (rural, remote, and very remote locations).

You must email clinical@amc.org.au by Sunday, September 21, 2025, specifying the exam date(s) you are applying for and providing evidence of residence and employment in an eligible location.

# **Evidence Required**

- Employer statement or documentation confirming work location in an MMM
   3-7 area
- Proof of residential address (e.g., electricity bill, driver's license, rental agreement) in an MMM 3-7 area
- Ahpra registration number

Priority will continue to be given to candidates currently working as medical practitioners. However, subject to availability, candidates residing in geographically remote areas within Australia will also be considered. Proof of residential address will be required for applicants from the following locations and their surrounding areas:

- Perth
- Townsville
- Cairns
- Northern Territory (NT) locations
