AMC Clinical Examination Scheduling (February – April 2026)

The AMC is pleased to announce that scheduling will soon be available to all eligible candidates. The release of in-person clinical exam dates will cover positions available in February – April at our new state-of-the-art test center in Melbourne. The release is for in-person examinations only. The eligibility requirements for online examinations are available for viewing on the AMC Website. Examination placements for the February–April scheduling period will be released via the Scheduling Application, with payments facilitated through the Stripe® payment platform.

Payment process

For this scheduling release, the AMC will only accept payments made by credit card (Visa, MasterCard, American Express, JCB, UnionPay, Cartes Bancaires Mastercard, and Cartes Bancaires Visa). **Debit cards will not be accepted.**

As part of our ongoing improvements, the AMC is exploring a new payment platform to support future examination fee payments. The AMC plans to introduce a new, fully operational platform for future scheduling releases next year. A wider range of payment options will be available once the new system is operational. We appreciate your understanding and patience as we work to enhance your payment experience.

Payment fee

The Clinical examination fee is \$3,000 AUD, including a credit card surcharge of 0.96% for all credit card transactions.

| Monday, 10 November 2025 10AM AEDT <i>Scheduling is open for all eligible AMC candidates to schedule into an available in-person clinical examination</i> | From Monday, 10 November at 10:00 am AEDT, candidates can access the Scheduling Application through their Candidate Account. Once logged in, candidates should ensure they are on the “AMC Account – Landing Page,” navigate to “I want to proceed with AMC assessments,” and select “Clinical Examinations.” They can then follow the on-screen instructions to complete their booking. Note: The Scheduling Application will open at 10:00 am AEDT, and examination dates will only be visible once the application is active. |
| Booking the examination placement | Candidates are advised that examination positions may fill quickly. Unfortunately, not all candidates who log in to the Scheduling Application will be able to secure an examination position. A high volume of activity during the scheduling period may result in a 24-hour delay in processing placement letters and receipts. The AMC team will be responding to a high volume of emails following the release of a |

| | <p>scheduling event. Candidates will need to note that all emails are responded to in the order they are received, based on their timestamp. The AMC requests that candidates avoid sending multiple emails, as this may result in messages being marked as spam or lead to potential miscommunication.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Multiple Devices Warning</p> <p>The AMC advises candidates to follow the guidance below when attempting to book a clinical examination placement.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Do not use multiple devices to secure an examination placement. Doing so may prevent you from successfully booking your examination.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Use only one browser (Chrome/Edge/Safari/Firefox) on one device when accessing the scheduling application. The system will detect if you are logged in on another device (such as a laptop, desktop computer, mobile phone, or tablet) or log in on a new browser.</p> <p>Important: The browser (Chrome/Edge/Safari/Firefox) on your device that you first use to log in to your candidate account becomes your original session. You must continue using this browser on the same device to select your examination date and complete your payment.</p> <p>Once logged in, the system holds your credentials for 30 minutes. During this time, you cannot log in from another browser or another device, or you will see a “<i>Multiple devices detected</i>” message when trying to access the scheduling page. If this occurs, return to your original browser on your device to complete your booking.</p> |
