

The AMC examinations and assessment process is for non-specialist International Medical Graduates (IMGs) (not Australian or New Zealand graduates) who are undertaking the standard pathway to <u>registration</u> with the Medical Board of Australia.

Please note: The AMC certificate will be issued with the first and last names as stated on the IMG's AMC account.

No name changes to the AMC certificate will be accepted once the certificate has been issued.

IMGs are required to submit their medical degree (final medical diploma/primary medical qualification) in clinical medicine and surgery for verification. It is important to determine whether your medical school as well as your degree title and graduation year are eligible.



Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the <u>Primary Source Verification</u> (PSV) process flowchart, including applying for a MyIntealth account and establishing a portfolio.

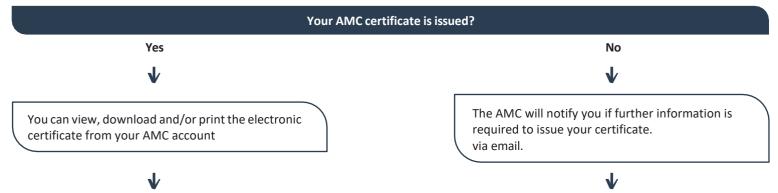

After your results have been published on your AMC account, the AMC will proceed with issuing the electronic AMC certificate.

Please allow up to 5 business days for the certificate to be generated.





Please note: The Medical Board of Australia/Ahpra and the nominated Australian/Australasian specialist medical college(s)(if applicable) will have access to view your verification and qualification information, AMC certificate and specialist assessment outcome (uploaded by your nominated specialist medical college, if applicable) via the AMC portal.
