

The AMC examinations and assessment [process](#) is for non-specialist International Medical Graduates (IMGs) (not Australian or New Zealand graduates) who are undertaking the standard pathway to [registration](#) with the Medical Board of Australia.

Please note: The AMC certificate will be issued with the first and last names as stated on the IMG's AMC account.

No name changes to the AMC certificate will be accepted once the certificate has been issued.

IMGs are required to submit their medical degree (final medical diploma/primary medical qualification) in clinical medicine and surgery for verification. It is important to determine whether your medical school as well as your degree title and graduation year are [eligible](#).
